## 6 STEPS TO TAKE AFTER BEING BIT BY A DOG

### 1 IDENTIFY THE DOG THAT BIT YOU



### 2 SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION

Depending on the severity of the injury, contact your doctor or visit the emergency room for medical attention. **ALWAYS** seek medical care after a dog bite.








